Roadwork Ahead!

In early December, the Maricopa County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) contractor will place grouted rip-rap around the historical Forest Service concrete drop structure and guardrail posts located on Seven Springs Road turn number 3 near milepost 4.2. This work is a safety improvement to stop erosion around the structure. The project is slated for completion at the end of December 2009. This project is being constructed in partnership with the U.S. Forest Service.

Construction Work Hours:

Work hours will be 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Some weekend work may be required.

Traffic Restrictions

During construction, lane restrictions and delays are anticipated. Traffic will be restricted to only one lane with flaggers during the work day. After normal working hours, the lanes will reopen with lighted barricades in place. Emergency access will be maintained at all times.
