Phase 2 Roadwork Ahead!

Beginning early February, the Maricopa County Department of Transportation (MCDOT), in partnership with the Gila River Indian Community, will begin improving the 51st Avenue intersections at Tashquinth Drive, Judum Street and Bunn Street. Traffic safety improvements include paving and widening the intersections, the installation of right and left-turn lanes on 51st Avenue for westbound and eastbound travel, curbed radius returns, ADA handicap ramps, street lighting and new signing and pavement markings. In addition, to improve pedestrian safety, especially at night, the project includes the installation of a lighted crosswalk near the ball park at Tashquinth Drive with user-activated flashing warning signs installed along the roadside at each end of the crosswalk and flashing warning lights, extending the entire width of 51st Avenue, installed directly into the pavement surface. The project is slated for completion in May 2010.

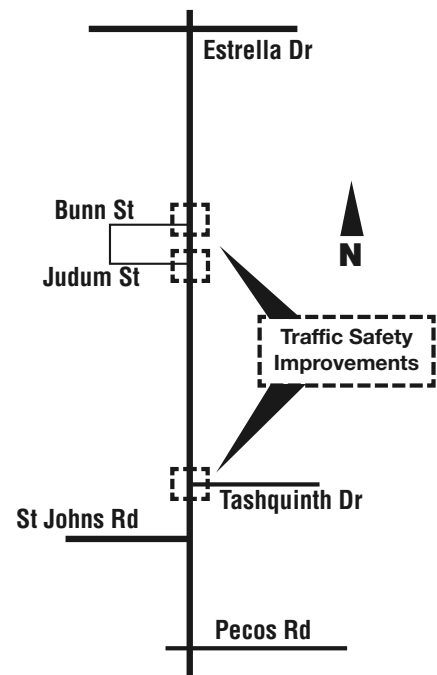
