Roadwork Ahead!

Beginning March 8, 2010, the Maricopa County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) contractor will start construction and paving activities on the existing dirt road section of Gompers Circle between Green Road and Weinberg Road. Improvements include the construction of a two-lane roadway (one travel lane in each direction). Additional improvements include the installation of curb and gutter on each side of the roadway and pavement of the connecting dirt road segments of Green Road and Weinberg Road. Currently, crews are onsite relocating utilities in advance preparation for the roadway improvements.

Upon completion, this portion of Gompers Circle will be added to the MCDOT Roadway Management System for all future roadway maintenance and operation activities. Project completion is scheduled for June 2010.

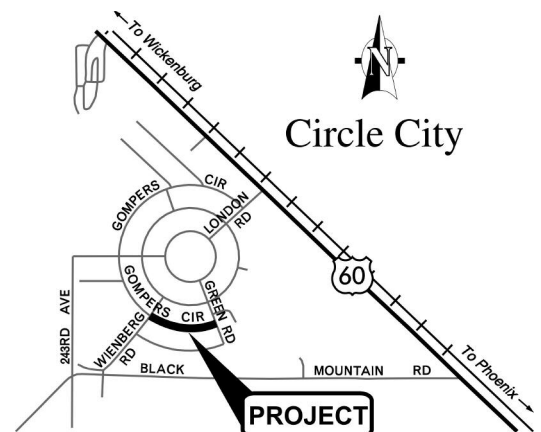
