On **March 1, 2010**, the Maricopa County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) contractor will begin milling the edges of Rio Verde Drive between 136th Street and Forest Road and installing a five-foot wide section of asphalt on the dirt shoulders. The project will add a bike lane on each side of the roadway. Additional improvements include the installation of pipe culverts, new guardrail, signing, striping, and hydro seeding to re-vegetate the roadway shoulders.

Work is slated for completion in late June 2010, weather permitting.

Construction work hours will be 5:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Hours may vary with seasonal changes and weekend work may be needed.

Work Zone Traffic Restrictions

During construction activity, expect traffic lane restrictions and pilot cars to facilitate traffic through the work zone. Access will be maintained at all times. Please obey flag persons and temporary traffic control signage. In addition, give yourself plenty of time to get where you are going as there may be traffic delays.

The Maricopa County Department of Transportation environmental air quality dust abatement program is paving and improving dirt roads and dirt shoulders in the MCDOT Roadway System in compliance with federal EPA mandates and Maricopa County's air quality plan.
